

## GCSE Media Studies WJEC



For GCSE Media Studies candidates must study both units. All units also have a written portfolio of work that demonstrates their skills and knowledge the Media Industry.

Unit 1 Thinking about the Media (External) 40% of total	This is an external written exam comprising of both analysis and production tasks for a range of mediums. Students will produce creative task like storyboards, advertisements, posters etc. in response to a brief set by the exam board.
Investigating and Planning	They will also answer question in essay format in response to a set topic focussing on genre, narrative or representations in media.
Unit 2 Creating the Media (Internal)	This unit comprises of two text analysis essay questions focusing on topics like print, advertising, marketing and film.
30% of total	A final large scale production piece will also be completed. This could include;
Investigating and Producing	<ul> <li>A music video</li> <li>TV advert</li> <li>Radio show</li> <li>Print Journalism – Magazine/ Newspaper</li> <li>Web based media</li> <li>Computer gaming</li> <li>Animation</li> </ul>
